NOTICE OF ACTION SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a meeting of the Town Board on Thursday, May 16, 2024, the Town Board of the Town of Minden, New York duly adopted Resolution No. 26 of 2024, entitled “RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MINDEN, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), DATED MAY 16, 2024, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE TOWN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000.00 TO FINANCE A PORTION OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING THE NEW TOWN OFFICES AND HIGHWAY GARAGE.” Such bond resolution is subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Section 90 of the New York Town Law.

Said resolution authorizes the construction of New Town Offices and Highway Garage, which has a period of probable usefulness of thirty (30) years.

Said resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days after adoption, unless there shall be filed with the Town Clerk a petition signed and acknowledged in a form and as required by New York Town Law Section 91 requesting that the matter be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town at a referendum in the manner provided by the Town Law.

A copy of the resolution is available for public inspection during normal business hours at the Office of the Town Clerk, temporarily located at 168 Canal Street, Fort Plain, New York 13339.
